A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Coupeville School District No. 204,
 Island County, Washington, adopting the 2015-2016 budget.

WHEREAS, WAC 392-123-054 requires that the board of directors of every school district meet for the purpose of fixing and adopting the budget of the district for the ensuing fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, a public notice was published announcing that on July 27, 2015, the Board of Directors of the Coupeville School District No. 204, Island County, Washington, would meet in a public meeting for the purpose of fixing and adopting the 2015-2016 Fiscal Budget for the district, and

WHEREAS, the board held a public hearing July 27, 2015, accepted public comment on the draft budget;

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 28A.320.330 the Board of Directors, as part of the budget adoption, authorizes the following operating transfers:

Capital Projects	Debt Service	Approximately \$40,000	December 2015	Interest and Principal payment
Capital Projects	Debt Service	Approximately \$5,000	June 2016	Interest payment

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Coupeville School District No. 204, Island County, Washington, to adopt the 2015-2016 budget for the district, and the final appropriation level of expenditures for each fund in will be as follows:

General Fund	\$10,484,447
Transportation Vehicle Fund	135,000
Capital Projects Fund	1,213,000
Debt Service Fund	2,000,000
Associated Student Body Fund	279,665
