CSD now uses Qmlativ as our student management system. This platform updates and hopefully improves on Skyward. Qmlativ is now where students and parents can check grades, contact teachers, and pay fees. There will be brief training provided to help parents and students navigate the new system shortly.

Lunch

The USDA has discontinued free lunch for all students. Lunch for students returns to \$3.45. We will also return to our two lunch bell schedule. That means we will have 6th-8th lunch after 3rd period, and 9th-12th lunch after 4th period.

Sports Registration Day: August 17th from 12:00 pm - 5:00 pm

CMHS will host a registration day for all students in grades 6-12 who wish to compete in athletics this school year. This will be the best time to complete all forms, pay fees, and ensure physicals are current. Students will not be allowed to participate until all of these tasks are complete so attending the Registration Day will be the most efficient way to make sure you have everything taken care of before first practices. Final Forms Information

We are very excited to announce that the Coupeville Middle and High School Athletic Department has partnered with FinalForms, an online forms and data management service. FinalForms allows you to complete and sign athletic participation forms for your students. The most exciting news is that FinalForms saves data from season-to-season and year-to-year, meaning that you will never need to enter the same information twice! FinalForms also pre-populates information wherever possible, for each of your students, saving you time.

You may review your data at any time to verify it is current. You will be required to sign your forms once per year and after any update.

Click on the Parent Playbook (attached) to get started in FinalForms. If you require any support during the process, scroll to the page bottom and click "Use Support".

We are asking that ALL parents of athletes use FinalForms. Please register at: coupeville-wa.finalforms.com and follow the prompts to create your account, create your students and sign your forms.

If the school has a current sports physical for your student, it will be attached to their account once the parent has added the student athlete registration. Final Forms keeps the secretaries up to date on new accounts added and physicals will be added as soon as possible.

Students will need to sign the electronic documents as well and may do so with their school email.
