## Connecting a Chromebook to Wi-Fi

After powering up and before logging in with the Chromebook, you may be greeted with either a **Network not available** window or a general login screen.

If you see **Network not available**, your Wi-Fi network will be listed.

- 1. Click the name of your Wi-Fi network
- 2. Enter the password for your Wi-Fi network
- 3. Click the blue Connect button

If you *don't* see **Network not available**, but instead a general login screen, follow these steps.

- 1. select the **time** at the bottom right of the screen.
- 2. In the settings window that displays, select Not Connected  $\bigtriangledown$ .
- 3. Turn on Wi-Fi.
- 4. Your Chromebook will automatically look for available networks and show them to you in a list.
- 5. Select your Wi-Fi network
- 6. Enter the password for your Wi-Fi network
